

Kappa Delta Pi Teacher Grant Guidelines Fall 2011

1. **All grant amounts are \$125** unless a project specifically outlines the cost will be less than \$125, in which case KDP will only fund it at the level of expense. Compensation for a teacher, teacher's aide, or substitute teacher is not funded nor are personnel salaries or stipends.
2. Online application must be complete to be eligible for funding
3. The applicant must be an active Kappa Delta Pi member. Inactive members will not be reviewed.
4. Applicants must be fulltime pre-K–12 teachers at a public, private, or parochial school.
5. Only applications received by the end of business day by September 9, 2011 will be considered for the fall 2011 grant cycle.
6. Your application needs to include a cost breakdown for the equipment or activity proposed. If additional funds are needed beyond the Educational Foundation grant award of \$125, the source of additional funding and amount contributed needs to be stated.
7. Programs or projects that are in conflict with Kappa Delta Pi's mission and purpose will not be considered.
8. The purpose of the grant is to fund innovative and unique programs in the classroom, or to provide teacher-members with much-needed classroom supplies. The projects and supplies should engage students in the learning process through hands-on activities, affect classroom instruction, promote creative and innovative ways of learning or approach curriculum from an imaginative angle.
9. All funds given must be used toward the project or supplies cost or returned to KDP.
10. Due to the limited amount of funds, only one grant per school building will be awarded.
11. Grant recipients will be notified by November 4, 2011 and a check will be mailed to the address provide in the application. A final report, with appropriate photo documentation, is due by June 30, 2012.
