



## 2012 INTERNATIONAL SCHOLARSHIPS

### KAPPA DELTA PI EDUCATIONAL FOUNDATION

#### UNDERGRADUATE/GRADUATE/DOCTORAL/PROFESSIONAL

- **Harold D. Drummond Scholarships** for four undergraduate or graduate students in Elementary Education; \$500 each.
- **J. Everett and Louise Light Scholarship** for one undergraduate, graduate, or doctoral student in Special Education; \$925.
- **Marsh Writing/Research Scholarship Award – Martha S. Marsh, Virginia Horns-Marsh and Frank E. Marsh** for one undergraduate and one graduate student who write research papers based on issues that affect teachers and learning; \$450 each.
- **MBNA Scholarship** for one undergraduate or graduate student in Special Education; \$1,000.
- **Donna Gail Shaw Scholarship for Chapter Service** for one undergraduate, graduate, or doctoral student, or practicing K–12 educator in the first three years of teaching; \$1,000.
- **Joekel Scholarship** for one undergraduate, graduate, or doctoral student, or practicing educator—priority to Nebraska Wesleyan University students and alumni; \$1,000.

#### UNDERGRADUATE ONLY

- **ATE/KDP National Student Teacher/Intern of the Year Award** for one student teacher; \$900. *Requires a separate application and the deadline is May 11, 2012.*
- **Sandra Jo Hornick Scholarships** for two undergraduate students—one for a KDP member and one for a student at Kent State University; \$1,000 each.
- **J. Jay Hostetler Scholarships** for two undergraduate student teachers; \$500 each (one awarded in the spring; one in the fall).
- **William B. Martin East Carolina University Scholarship** for one undergraduate student in Special Education or Middle Grades Education student at East Carolina University; \$1,000.
- **Jerry Robbins Scholarship** for one undergraduate student in Instrumental Music (band and/or orchestra); \$1,000.

#### DOCTORAL ONLY

- **Hollis L. Caswell Laureate Scholarship** in Curriculum and Instruction; \$4,000.
- **O. L. Davis, Jr. Laureate Scholarship** in Curriculum and Instruction; \$3,000.
- **Barbara Day Laureate Scholarship** in Curriculum and Instruction; \$875.
- **Paul R. Hanna Laureate Scholarship** in Childhood Education; \$1,900.
- **C. Glen Hass Laureate Scholarship** in Instructional Leadership at the University of Florida only; \$1,500.
- **Henry H. Hill Laureate Scholarship** in Educational Administration; \$1,500.
- **Marcella L. Kysilka Doctoral Student Scholarship** in Curriculum Studies or Educational Psychology; \$2,000.
- **Gerald H. Read Laureate Scholarship** in International and Comparative Education; \$2,750.
- **Deborah Partridge Wolfe Laureate Scholarship** in Multicultural Education; \$2,000

## GENERAL APPLICATION GUIDELINES – PLEASE READ CAREFULLY.

- All scholarship candidates must be active KDP members.
  - All applications must be submitted using the online application.
  - Applications must be submitted by midnight EST on **April 27, 2012**, to be considered.
  - Recipients will be announced no later than July 31, 2012.
1. The application and all attached statements must be **typed**.
  2. The applicant must be an active (current dues paid) member in good standing. Each application must include the applicant's Kappa Delta Pi membership number.
  3. The applicant must use the award for study in a recognized college of education or education-related graduate school.
  4. All applicants must have a typed reference.
    - Chapter member candidates must provide a reference signed by the KDP Chapter Counselor noting the applicant's participation in the chapter, particularly the scope of involvement and leadership positions, and the applicant's potential as a professional.
    - Professional member candidates must provide a reference signed by their supervisor or academic advisor who can attest to the applicant's potential as a professional and note the scope of involvement and any leadership positions held in the applicant's graduate program and/or teaching position.
    - Doctoral scholarship candidates must provide a reference signed by a faculty advisor or department chair in the applicant's major field who can assess the applicant's academic and professional potential.
  5. The application must include a current transcript(s) of all college work completed to date.
  6. A screening committee of prominent Kadelpians will review each application. The decisions of this committee are final. All materials submitted will become the property of the Society with all rights thereof reserved by the Society.
  7. ***All applicants are required to write an essay. Applications without required essays attached or written on the wrong topic will not be considered.*** Unless a specific essay topic for the scholarship you are applying for is listed below, all applicants must write an original essay of no more than 750 words that portrays a personal vision of himself or herself as an educator and how he or she hopes to make a difference.

## SCHOLARSHIPS REQUIRING A SPECIFIC ESSAY TOPIC OR ADDITIONAL DOCUMENTATION

**Harold D. Drummond Scholarship.** Essay Topic (no more than 750 words): What can I contribute as an elementary teacher? In addition, a statement of financial need is required.

**J. Jay Hostetler Scholarship.** A statement of financial need is required.

**Joekel Scholarship.** Essay Topic (minimum 2 pages, double-spaced, 1" margins): Address the following 2 areas. Provide specific examples when possible. A. Discuss how your work and approach to education addresses the four KDP ideals: humanity, science, service, and toil B. Share any other background information that helps the committee assess your potential as a future educator and leader.

**Marcella L. Kysilka Doctoral Student Scholarship.** Essay Topic (no more than 750 words): What is the relationship between the fields of Curriculum Studies and Educational Psychology? Additional requirements: Teaching experience, preferably at the secondary level.

**MBNA Scholarship.** Essay Topic (no more than 750 words): What are the challenges facing teachers working with special needs students?

**Donna Gail Shaw Scholarship for Chapter Service.** Essay Topic (no more than 750 words): The role of service in becoming a professional educator. Additional documentation required: on a separate sheet, provide a description of your service to the chapter, community, and profession, and how your service made a difference.

## **Marsh Writing/Research Scholarship Award – Martha S. Marsh, Virginia Horns-Marsh and Frank E. Marsh**

In place of the standard application essay, submit a research paper completed between July 1, 2011, and April 27, 2012, as part of an undergraduate or graduate program in a recognized school or college of education. Individuals may nominate their own papers, or nominations may be made by advisors, department chairs, deans, KDP Chapter Counselors, or Chapter Presidents. Each nomination must include a completed application. Papers will be considered on the basis of the following criteria:

- A. Significant topic.
- B. Adequacy and appropriateness of methodology. (Entries representing various methodologies are encouraged, e.g., experimental, ethnographic, statistical, historical, survey.)
- C. Writing clarity.
- D. Potential contribution to the field.

**All Doctoral Level Scholarship Applications.** Essay Topic (no more than 750 words): Why are you pursuing a doctoral degree and how do you plan to impact the field of education? Additional requirements and documentation:

- A. Must already have been admitted for doctoral level study at a recognized graduate school or college of education.
- B. Must have successful experience in teaching or another professional education position.
- C. Submit a current résumé or vita.
- D. Submit an approved program prospectus or course of study.

## **SCHOLARSHIP CHECKLIST**

### **All Applications**

- Application is filled in completely and includes KDP membership number.
- Essay and Application are typed and verified by applicant.
- Reference is typed and signed by:
  - Chapter Counselor for KDP chapter members or
  - Supervisor or academic advisor for KDP professional members or
  - Faculty advisor or department chair for doctoral scholarship candidates
- Transcripts are attached.

### **All Doctoral Applications**

- Current résumé or vita is attached.
- Approved program prospectus or course of study is attached.

### **Marsh Writing/Research Scholarship Award Application**

- Research paper is attached (instead of essay).

### **Donna Gail Shaw Scholarship for Chapter Service Application**

- Additional documentation describing your service is attached.

### **Harold D. Drummond Scholarship Application**

- Statement of financial need is attached.

### **J. Jay Hostetler Scholarship Application**

- Statement of financial need is attached.

### **Joekel Scholarship Application**

- Statement of financial need is attached.
