This scholarship was established by J. Nannette McLain in honor of Marcella Kysilka's dedication to Kappa Delta Pi and to the education profession. Thus, in keeping with the interests of these two educators, the Kappa Delta Pi Educational Foundation is awarding one scholarship for doctoral students in the Curriculum Studies or Educational Psychology areas of study. Each Kappa Delta Pi chapter may submit one candidate for each scholarship.

The Kysilka Doctoral Scholarship winner will receive an award of **\$2,000**.

Rules

1. The application and all attached statements must be **typed**. (See www.kdp.org for forms.)
2. The scholarship recipient must use the award for doctoral study with an emphasis on general curriculum studies or educational psychology at a regionally and/or nationally accredited university program.
3. The award is for the 2005–2006 school year.
4. The scholarship will be awarded to the most highly qualified individual, regardless of "race, age, color, religion, sex, or handicapping condition." (Kappa Delta Pi Constitution, Article I, Section 2)
5. The applicant must be an active (current dues paid) member in good standing. Each application must include the applicant's membership number.
6. Application forms may be secured from any Kappa Delta Pi Chapter Counselor or by contacting the Kappa Delta Pi Educational Foundation Office at 1-800-284-3167.
7. Applicants must meet the following criteria:
 - ☞ Must have already been admitted for doctoral level study at a recognized graduate school or college of education.
 - ☞ Must have had successful experience in teaching or another professional education position, preferably in secondary education.
 - ☞ Must be recommended by a faculty member or chair in the applicant's major field who can assess his/her academic and professional potential.

A Note to Chapter Counselors: No more than one (1) application per chapter will be accepted in each scholarship category listed above.
