Team Leaders are responsible for teaching and supervising groups of 14–18 students in small groups, on field trips, during meals, and as resident advisors at the conference centers. Office staff members are responsible for the smooth transition from academics to logistics and operational support of the conferences.

### **EARN A STIPEND AND COLLEGE CREDIT**

Staff will receive a stipend for each individual 6, 10, or 11-day conference worked plus a bonus at the end of the summer (see our Web site for conference details). Travel to and from the conference is included (within the continental United States), as well as room and board and admission to all conference activities. Staff members typically work 3 or 4 sessions during the spring/summer with a few days break between each session. For summer, staff members will attend a mandatory training session in the Washington, DC area in early June 2006. For spring, staff members will attend a training session a few days prior to the start of the first conference.

In addition, staff will have the opportunity to earn up to three undergraduate or graduate credits while staffing *LeadAmerica* conferences. The credits are fully transferable from Loras College ([www.loras.edu](http://www.loras.edu)), a four-year, fully accredited, liberal arts college.
