- The Event- make sure to take pictures of your chapter's involvement in the event
- After the event, send out a newsletter to thank all participants and update the chapter. Organize all flyers, newsletters, pictures and other information into one file in preparation for the upcoming ACE award.
- Start planning for the next project!
