Submissions

Award entries must be submitted via the online submission system.

Judging

Qualified judges with strong knowledge of the Society and chapter management will be appointed.

Notification

Award recipients will be notified by email by July 19, 2019.

Presentation

Award recipients will be honored online, via a recommendation letter from Headquarters, and at the Kappa Delta Pi Convocation in Norfolk, VA in October 2019.

Eligibility

- Each chapter can nominate one officer for this award each year, unless two individuals equally share the position's responsibilities (Co-Presidents) with the same tenure dates.
- Nominee's term of office was during the 2018–2019 academic year.
- Letter of support from chapter counselor outlining why the nominee meets the criteria for the award.
- Letter of support from a fellow officer outlining why the nominee meets the criteria for the award.

Criteria

- **Chapter Leadership.** Describe the achievements and improvements accomplished and the goals realized by the chapter during the nominee's term of office. What was his/her role in these improvements and changes?
- **Building Relationships.** Describe the relationships the nominee developed with his/her chapter counselor, fellow chapter officers, and chapter members. How did s/he build those relationships?
- **Chapter and Society Involvement.** Describe the nominee's involvement in chapter programs or activities and his/her attendance or involvement in Kappa Delta Pi's Society programs and activities.
- **Society Mission and Values.** Describe how the experience of holding a chapter officer position relates to the Society's mission and values and his/her career in education.

Submission Requirements

- A complete online submission will consist of:
 - Online entry form;
 - Supporting narrative for each of the criteria areas – from the nominee, the chapter counselor, or a fellow officer;
 - Letter of support from chapter counselor; and
 - Letter of support from fellow officer.
