



Kappa Delta Pi International Scholarship Program Overview

KDP International Scholarship Program is made possible through generous endowment donations to support the future of education. All recipients maintain a high grade point average, participate in their Kappa Delta Pi chapter, and write an essay as part of their application. Each scholarship also has its own set of criteria. The amounts of the scholarships vary as well. A review committee evaluates the applicants.

Applications are accepted each spring. Scholarship opportunities and criteria will be posted by February 1, 2018. The 2018 submittal period will open February 1 and conclude May 1. Recipients will be announced June 15, 2018.

Scholarships are available for multiple levels of study including undergraduate, graduate, doctoral, and practicing educators.

- All scholarship candidates must be active KDP members, any exceptions are listed with the opportunity.
- All applications and required documentation must be submitted using the online application process.
- No materials will be accepted via email or postal mail. You may need to scan documents to create a digital copy that can be attached electronically to your application.
- Unofficial transcripts are accepted

To submit your application, you must have the following documents available for upload.

- Essay or research paper covering the specific topic required for the scholarship you are applying for.
- Reference letter from the correct individual required by this scholarship program
- Transcript – undergraduate & graduate members only
- Transcript with current courses in progress or approved program prospectus – doctoral members only
- CV or resume – doctoral members only
- Explanation of scholarship use – professional educators only
- Statement of financial need – Drummond and Hostetler
- Description of service – Shaw applications only
