interviews with candidates during Q2 of the second year of the

biennium and meeting at Convocations

Expectations: Specific tasks completed between meetings, as determined by

committee. To participate in all meetings and complete action items, as

assigned by committee chair, in a timely manner.

Note: If a committee member does not participate in three (3)

consecutive meetings without chair notification, the committee member

may be subject to dismissal from the committee.

Desired Qualifications and Attributes:

Active KDP member

Key Responsibilities:

- Oversee Executive Council election and leadership development processes.
 - Solicit from the membership nominations for officers of the Society no later than seven (7) months prior to the end of the current biennium. (This process, ideally, would begin September or October of 2019.)
 - Receive written nominations no later than five (5) months prior to the end of the current biennium.
 - o Interview all nominees and prepare an election slate, including biographical data on each candidate.
 - O Submit the election slate and ballot via KDP Headquarters to all active members no later than three (3) months prior to the end of the current biennium for a vote.
 - Recommend names for consideration by the President as appointed members of the Council whose expertise aligns with the strategic goals of the Society.
- Develop a leadership succession program for KDP committees and the Executive Council.
